**COMMUNITY NOTICES CHILDREN TRAVEL FREE ON WEEKENDS** Auckland Transport has an exciting opportunity for your students. From Saturday 7 September, children under the age of 16 who have an AT HOP card will be able to travel free on Auckland Transport's weekend services. It's been three years since AT Metro introduced the 99 cent fares on weekends for children that made it easier and cheaper for children to get around Auckland at the weekend. Now, Auckland Transport is offering a 100% discount on weekend fares for children 5 to 15 (inclusive) travelling on buses, trains and participating ferries. This comes as part of the \$1.1 million contribution from Auckland Council towards public transport initiatives, announced earlier this year.
