### **End of Term News**

### **Traffic Safety Around the School**

A reminder that Traffic Wardens are now starting to visit our school regularly as our students are leaving in the afternoon. It is important that you park legally to ensure you do not receive a ticket. *PLEASE help to keep our students safe by parking safely and legally.* You

will be aware that all passengers – including babies and small children – must have the correct "restraints" or seatbelts. The law is changing on 1<sup>st</sup> October. This means parents and whanau now need to ensure that the correct restraints are in place for all passengers. The new law raises the age for using child restraints (as opposed to the usual seatbelt) so that children up to 8 years old must now have either booster seats or proper restraints instead of seatbelts.

### **Lost Property**

Last few days to claim any lost property – this is all un-named clothing, shoes, hats etc. After 3pm on Friday, things left here will be taken away and donated to charity. The good thing is, if you have named your children's property we can return it to them.
