## 2019 ENROLMENTS

The board of Fairburn School has adopted an enrolment scheme which has been approved by the Ministry of Education.

Under this scheme, students who live outside the 'home zone' can apply to enter our ballot if they want to attend the school. For 2019, there are limited spaces in all year levels. Therefore, there will be a ballot for out of zone students.

The ballot for entry in Term 1 2019 will be held on 29th October. All applications for enrolment must be in by **17th October**. We will then hold a ballot each term if there are any spaces available. The enrolment scheme, which includes a precise description of the home zone, may be viewed at the school office, or on our website. This also applies to siblings of current students so please ensure you enrol in time.
