CELEBRATING CULTURES

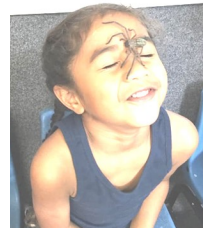
On Friday 5th April we came together as one big Fairburn family to celebrate our wide and diverse variety of cultures.
