ENROLMENTS FOR 2020

All year 6 students need to be enrolled at the Intermediate School they will be attending in 2020, by the end of term 3. If you have not yet done this, please ensure that you make it a priority over the next few weeks. Intermediate Schools need enrolment information this term, to plan for 2020, to ensure they have enough teachers and classrooms for all the students. Your information also helps to ensure that your child is placed in the right class grouping. We have enrolment forms for Otahuhu Intermediate and Papatoetoe Intermediate at the office. Otahuhu Intermediate forms can be returned to us and we forward them on.

SAFETY AT THE SCHOOL GATE

If you are going to be late picking your child up at 2.50pm, your child for safety reasons MUST wait in the appropriate place which is outside the school library where they are supervised. Students will not be allowed to wait at the front gate as there is no supervision available and congregating there is causing safety issues. Students are playing in this area, running across the driveway and climbing on the gates. There is a designated safe area (for those families who are occasionally late) where children can wait. At 3:10pm the last students waiting are taken to the office and parents are contacted. If you are going to be consistently late, SKIDS afterschool care is available on site. Your presence at, or contact with the school may make it more difficult for us to manage the situation and could potentially place your children and in fact yourselves at risk.
