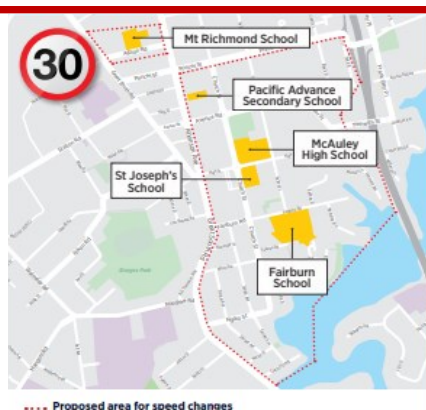
PAPER BAGS
